

Disney Chaperone Duties/Responsibilities:

- Ride the bus the entire trip.
- Monitor Students on the bus.
- Share a room with another Chaperone or Chaperones.
- When on Bus and arriving at Hotel (Every Evening):
 - Remind Students of Call times.
 - Get medications.
 - Get new towels before going back up to the room.
- Check Rooms (Every Night):
 - Make sure all students are in the room.
 - Check bathroom, under bed, balcony, closets, etc.
 - Tape Door
- You are responsible for administering medication and minor first aid at the Hotel and in the Parks to your assigned students.
- Please remember all school district rules (see below) apply on this trip and breaking them will result in immediate removal from the trip at your own expense, with no refunds.
 - Refrain from inappropriate language and behavior.
 - No smoking around students, please use the designated Disney Smoking Areas.
 - No drinking/consuming alcohol.
 - No going off Campus (Past ticket booths between Disneyland and California Adventure, which means Downtown Disney is off limits.)
- You Must be Fingerprinted at the School District and cleared, call district for fee and appointment.
- You must Sign the Chaperone Agreement Form.
- Chaperoning is a job, not a vacation.

- We ask if you have other children attending, that only one parent chaperones with the group. In the event of a non-student emergency, the second parent can go with them, while maintaining our required student-to-chaperone ratio. Thank you for your understanding.
