

RHSEU Late Night Bingo (Scarlet Brigade / Bingo Hall Dress Code and Rules)

- Must wear closed toe shoes.
- Must wear shirts with sleeves (short sleeves are OK—it is often too warm in the hall). No tank tops or sleeveless shirts. Band shirts are preferred, but not mandatory.
- No **short** shorts, or cut-offs.
- Please be professional, clean, and neat in appearance. Good hygiene is a must for the consideration of patrons.
- No smoking allowed while you work on the floor. This is a hall rule placed in order to avoid liabilities. The Late Night Session does not have an allotted “break time”. Floor sales have only three hours and need to sell as much flash on the floor as possible for our shift to be as beneficial for all charities concerned.
- Floor sales workers should be able to sell in both smoking and non-smoking rooms. In fairness, all workers must work in both rooms. We understand that some have health issues but we are not allowed to have more than 1 volunteer who can’t go back there per late night shift. **Please** let the PT Games coordinator know if you have health issues that are adversely affected by cigarette smoke.
- If you need to take a drink from the fridge in the back or use the bathroom, you must return flash bin, set it on PT Counter, and **TAKE OFF WORK VEST**. All items (bin/vest/money) must stay at PT Counter until your return. Please communicate with someone behind counter if you need to step away for a short time.
- Please remember that all candy and sodas are there for the volunteers to consume on your shift and in the hall. Eat and drink as much as you want, but please do not take any candy and sodas home.
