WINTER SEASON FAIR SHARE

The Winter Season fair share cost to participate in “L” Pattern is: **\$302.00**

Your student will need the following (as listed by www.marchingworld.com):

1. MACE

Browse to Drum Major > Maces > Maces

Select “American Mace” with the following options:

Finish:	Chrome
Shaft:	White
Dome:	Low Dome
Crowns:	Eagle & Practice
Chains or Cords:	None
Mace Shortening:	Please See Notes Below

- **MACE SHORTENING:** It is very important that your student has a mace that is of correct length. To measure, the correct length of the mace should be the height measurement from the ground (in marching shoes) to the highest point of the student’s armpit.
- The unmodified mace is approximately 58” in length.
- Select “Shorten to 57”, 56” or 55” if that is your required length.
- If you require a mace length measurement below 55”, select 55” from drop down menu and input the desired length in the “Order Notes” section available during final checkout.

Tip Guard Color: White Tip

White Gloves

Purchase a set (Both Left and Right) of White Golf Gloves (Available at Sporting Goods Stores and Departments)

White Electrical Tape

Purchase at any hardware store
