# What do we do?

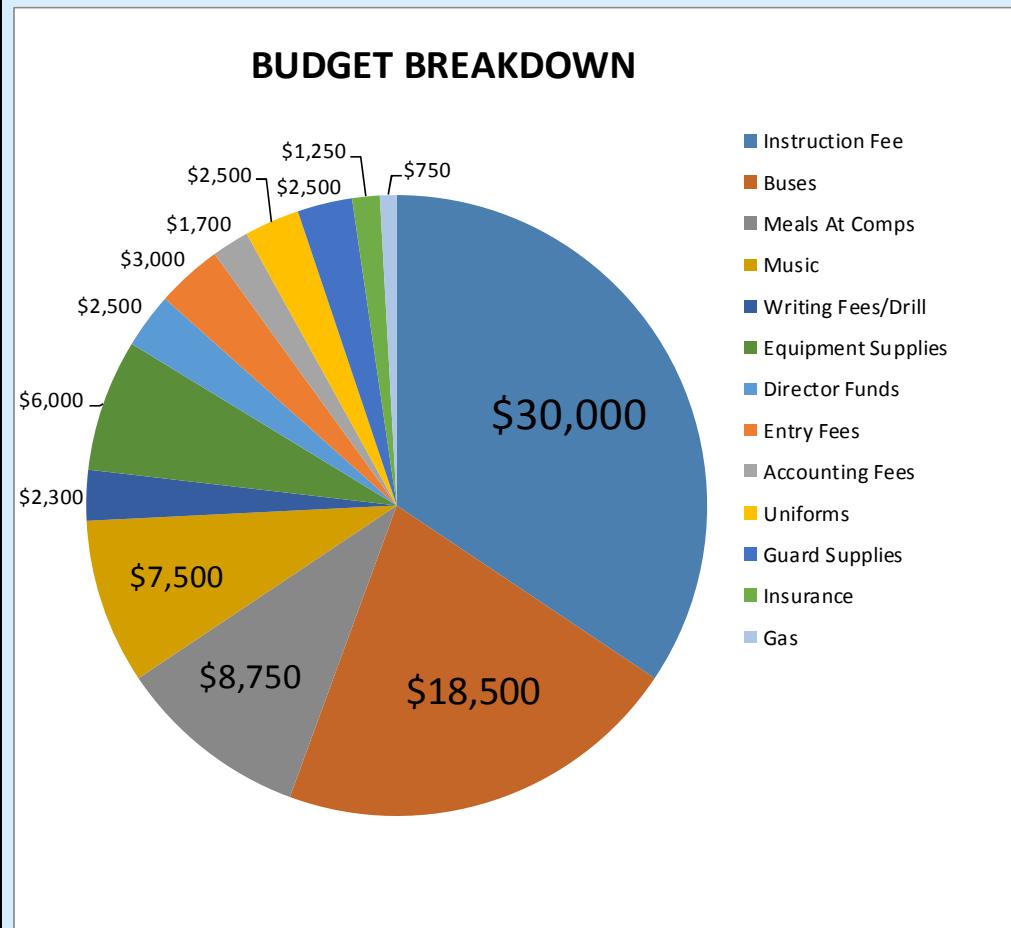


- The Rodriguez Music Boosters is a non-profit organization established to support the Rodriguez High School Music Program.
- The Boosters rely on fair share, fundraising from the bingo program, and other fundraising opportunities to support activities that are essential to a successful music program.
- Funds are used for instructors, equipment, music, entry fees for band reviews and festivals, uniforms, and many other expenses.
- The bingo program is a major source of funding, but we also must rely on alternative fundraising to meet our annual budget.

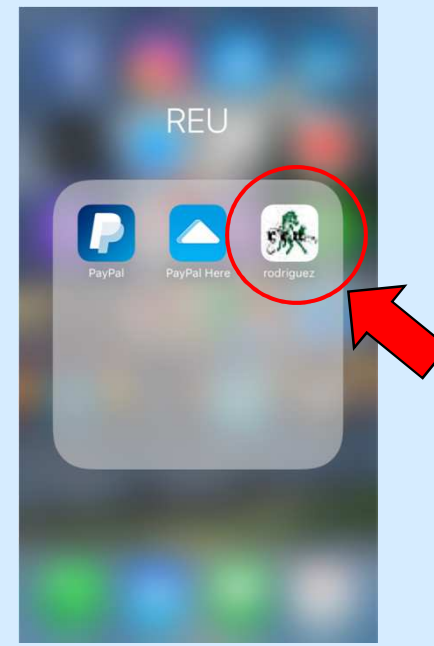
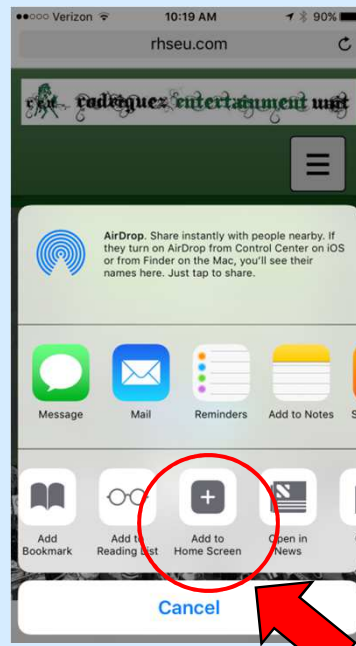
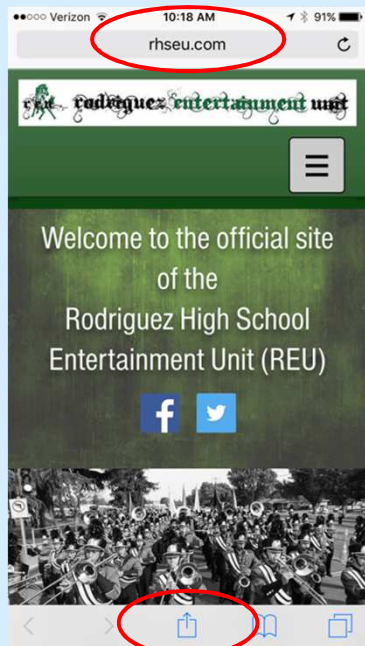


- Text messaging system for receiving information on what's happening in REU.
